FEMA update:

Lee will meet with Daniels Construction and then the next step is to put it out to bid. Another option is to apply for a structures grant.

Engineering on Camp Arden Road is almost complete.

The Crew has been hauling gravel and raking out muddy areas. Grading some roads is also being done. The crew will be taking the MSHA CPR training.

Lee is working on the Better Back Roads inventory.

On a motion by Terry and second from Maria the Board voted 5-0 to sign the MRGP (Municipal Roads General Permit) Annual Report. This pertains to water quality along sensitive roads.

Dan Bailey, Jessica Nelson & Julieanne Eagan spoke with the Board regarding proposed Dummerston School playground projects. The consensus was the Board was very supportive of the proposed projects. They would like a letter of support from the Board to help them secure grant funding. They were encouraged to work with Roger, Zoning Administrator to apply for any necessary permits.
